According to Part 5 of the Council of Government School Organisation's Constitution, the Executive Officer must be notified prior to the commencement of the session, the names of delegates, representatives and/or proxies who will be attending meetings of Council. **Return of this form meets Constitutional requirements.**

*Should your organisation not be able to send delegates to the council meeting and your school is more than 200km from the meeting venue, your organisation is entitled to send a **proxy**.*

A **proxy** may occur where:

- One delegate from a school is nominated to carry all the votes of that school
- An individual, not necessarily associated with a school group, is nominated to carry the affiliate organisation's votes
- You choose to be represented by someone with particular expertise to speak on a point of view

An affiliate organisation, located within the region in which a meeting is held, shall be entitled to exercise its full allocation of votes provided the organisation has a registered **delegate** already attending that meeting.
