11.3 School Feedback

Chair provided an opportunity to hear from members present:

- Palmerston College & Rosebery Primary are going to liaise and seek a traffic management study for their respective schools.
- Middle Point School are still to receive their Better Building Schools grant which will be used for an all purpose building.
- Palmerston College undertook a security audit several years ago and is seeking for the department to undertake a current security audit and fund the recommendations to reduce the costs of ongoing repairs to the campus. Since moving to the dual campus model money is stretched.
- Durack Primary are using their Better Building Schools grant for a new car park. They are working on an IT plan for the school and Council has taken over the OSHC.
- Driver Primary are spending their Better Building Schools grant on a middle year's playground.
 They have lost 50 student enrolments since Zuccoli Primary opened.
- Bakewell Primary are at capacity and are still having issues with traffic and carparking.
