2. BUSINESS ARISING

2.1 Action Items from Annual Full Council 2014

The 2014 Action Items were noted and discussed.

4.1 That the NTCOGSO constitution and policies will be reviewed to address issues of modernisation and relevance.

Report – The review identified two stages to the process.

Stage 1 to bring the constitution up to the compliance standard required by Department of Business (DoB). This work was completed by consultants Matrix on Board and a Special General Meeting was held electronically with the closing date of 12 September 2015. A quorum was reached which supported the motion and the constitution has been lodged with DoB.

Stage 2 is for School Councils to review for modernisation and relevance and feedback is now sought.

4.2 That COGSO Executive take urgent action to address the lack of access for students to see occupational, speech and behavioural therapists as there is currently a waiting period of up to 18 months.

Report – Placed on the agenda (Agenda Item 4.2) and information requested for the COGSO/CE (Chief Executive, Department of Education) meeting on 29 October 2014.

A summary sheet outlining the functions of Positive Learning Centres (PLCs) and the Malak Re-engagement Centre (MRC) was provided. Deputy Chief Executive, Susan Bowden confirmed occupational health etc services are provided through the Department of Health. The waiting times listed in the paper were provided by Health. DoE has had discussions with Heath regarding the waiting times. COGSO advised that in WA IPS schools were able to be creative, identified a space in the school for therapists and able to attract therapists in the area, if a child needed a therapist they didn't need to wait.

It was noted that DoE employed a speech pathologist and a speech and communication teacher through Australian Government funding to assist schools.

COSGO sought clarification of when the funding will finish.

for the regions not previously reported on by Department of Education in the 2014 motion; **Southern, Barkly, East Arnhem, Katherine** and **Palmerston & Rural** – the rural schools not included in last information).

Susan advised that meetings take place at the corporate, regional as well as multi agency meetings. COGSO advised there have been tensions where a school staff member report to DCF and are not provided any feedback. Susan advised that DCF have a high turnover of case workers. DoE is undertaking to develop an MOU to formalise relationships and processes with DCF / DoE. COGSO is following up and requesting the outcome of the development of MOU.
